
A landfill attendant will be onsite to inspect all items that will be deposited and to collect payments.

STREET IMPROVEMENT SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS LETTER

This letter is to notify you that the Special Assessment Commission of the City of Lakota has met for the purpose of determining the amount of benefit and consequent special assessment amount to be assessed against your property for the city project titled Street Improvement District #2018-1.

The assessment list was published on August 22nd and 28th, 2019, along with a notice for protest hearing, in the Lakota American. The Special Assessment Commission held the protest hearing at Lakota City Hall on September 9th, 2019 with one adjustment received.

The assessment amount for this project to be assessed against your property will be spread over the next Twenty years at the interest rate of 3%.

If you choose, you may pay the assessment amount in full prior to October 15, 2019, and no interest will be charged. Partial payments pay also be paid until October 15, 2019. Payments will be received at the Lakota City Office until the October 15th, 2019 deadline. After the October 15th, 2019 deadline an annual principal amount, plus interest will be certified to the Nelson County Auditor and will be placed on your property tax statement. The annual principal and interest will be certified to the Nelson County Auditor each October until maturity of the assessment bond.
