City Election

The city election is set for June 9, 2020 with positions open as follows: the mayor position, 3 council positions and 3 park board positions. The incumbents would be Mayor Jeff Russo, council members Dennis Mattern, Bill Solberg and Jim Vasichuk, park board - Tate Aronson and Racheal Karna with one vacant position. Deadline to return a completed petition is April 6th, 2020 at 4pm and returned to the Lakota City Hall at 108 East B Ave.

With the COVID-19 crisis and at the time of this newsletter, the city hall has been restricting access to the public, however, petitions can be dropped off at the utility payment drop box at city hall or mailed and received by 4pm on April 6th to PO Box 505 Lakota, ND. The drop box will be checked by office personnel at 4pm, April 6th, 2020.
