Budget Billing

Are the heating months putting a dent into your pocketbook? Have you considered looking into budget billing with Lakota Municipal Utilities? Budget billing is a great way to pay your utility account by averaging out the yearly usage.

With budget billing, there will be no surprise utility bill each month, we just require you to pay a set dollar amount each month with no late or delinquent payments.

Online System

Have you tried our online system? To view your account online go to www.lakotand.enerlyte.com and take a look. If you have not previously logged in you will need to click on the icon at the top right corner of the page. The information you need to do this is found on your utility bills you receive monthly.

Once you are logged in you will also be able to make a payment to your account, see your usage for the last 12 months and view past bills. Logging into this system does not require you to pay your bills online it is just another way you can view your current balance.

Pet License

Ordinance 13.0201 License Required

No dog or cat shall be permitted to be or remain in the city without being licensed as hereinafter provided if over one month of age. No license or renewal license shall be issued for a dog or cat over six months of age unless it has been inoculated against rabies.

Please stop in at City Hall to register your pets.
