Once you are logged in you will also be able to make a payment to your account and see your usage for the last 12 months. You can also have your bills emailed to you by changing your billing preference to paperless.

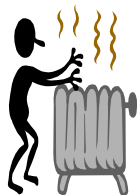
Pet License

Ordinance 13.0201 License Required

No dog or cat shall be permitted to be or remain in the city without being licensed as hereinafter provided if over one month of age. No license or renewal license shall be issued for a dog or cat over six months of age unless it has been inoculated against rabies. Please stop in at City Hall to register your pets.
