Water Meter Replacements

Lakota Municipal Utilities has started a water meter replacement project. This project is necessary as many of the meters are at the end of their expected lifespan and need to be changed to ensure accurate measurement, and will also bring the utility to the latest technology in meter reading.

Customers that are affected will be contacted by a member of the city staff to setup a date to change out the water meter. During installation, Lakota Municipal Utilities will need access to the water meter, typically located in the basement, utility room, or crawl space of your house. Water service will temporarily be interrupted during the procedure and the typical job will take 15-30 minutes.

Online System

Have you tried our online system? To view your account online go to www.lakotand.enerlyte.com and take a look. If you have not previously logged in you will need to click on the icon at the top right corner of the page. The information you need to do this is found on your utility bills you receive monthly.

Once you are logged in you will also be able to make a payment to your account, see your usage for the last 12 months and view past bills. Logging into this system does not require you to pay your bills online it is just another way you can view your current balance.
