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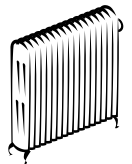

Sponsor A Day Fundraiser

The Lakota Swimming Pool currently has a Sponsor A Day Fundraiser going on to help with the cost of turning the unused wading pool into a zero entry wading pool, including water play & spray features and a circulating pump allowing continuous running time. The project will take place at the current site of the wading pool and the size will be approximately 16' wide X 40' long. This will be adjacent to the existing larger swimming pool that is directly to the east and within the Lakota swimming pool property. This project will meet ADA requirements providing a gradual sloped entrance for all patrons to enjoy.
