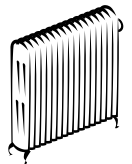

## Online System

Did you know that Lakota Municipal Utilities has a web site? If you go to [www.lakotand.enerlyte.com](http://www.lakotand.enerlyte.com) you can view your balance, pay your bill or even set up your bill to receive it by email. When you sign up to receive your bills by email they are received much faster than traditional mail as they are sent out the same day they are computed. You are also able to go back and look at or print past bills.

To use the online system you need your account number that is located on your bill. If you have questions on they online site, stop in at City Hall. We would be happy to help get your online account set up.
