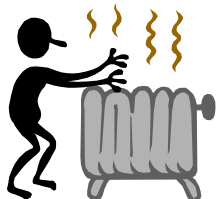
Free-Will dinner of Hamburgers or Hotdogs, chips, pickles and dessert will be served.



Landfill

The Landfill will change hours of operation to ONLY Saturday's 12pm-5pm starting October 1st. The landfill will remain open until approximately November 9th, weather permitting. A landfill attendant will be onsite to inspect all items that will be deposited. Items not permitted include: Paint & Oil, Tires, TV's, Computer Monitors, Household Waste, Electronics, Mercury Containing Devices, Batteries, Oil, Asbestos Containing Materials, Fluorescent and Incandescent bulbs.
